- Cleans and updates computer hardware and software to keep in proper working condition.
- Assists faculty, staff, and students with the use of a variety of computers.
- Develops computer and internet use policies and procedures.
- Demonstrates and provides instructions to students in proper use of computer equipment.
- Tutors students in their understanding and use of online learning platform.
- Troubleshoots computer operations to determine malfunctions.
- Performs repairs to hardware, and update software.
- Installs and maintains servers and performs networking duties.
- Works with faculty to ensure a positive learning environment in computer lab.
